• Candidate for admission to **Masters in Emergency Medicine (CCT-EM)(Certificate of Completion of Training in Emergency Medicine)** shall be required to possess the following qualifications:

- (a) He/she must have MBBS Degree from a medical college which is recognized by Medical Council of India, New Delhi.
- (b) Obtained permanent registration certificate from any of the State Medical Councils or Medical Council of India
- (c) Foreign Medical Graduates should have cleared their FMG screening exam before enrolling into the course and should have a valid registration from Medical Council of India.
